

## 2008-09 Season Agreement

Coordination of Teams between JFC and Fire.

JFC and Fire will coordinate at least three teams for the 2008-09 season. For each of the following age groups, this will be the primary competitive team for both clubs:

1. The U18 boys team will be coached by Chad Hampton. The team will be rostered as a Fire team with MSA. Coach compensation will be paid by Fire.
2. The U16 girls team will be coached by Bill Hood, and Montgomery Hinton will be assistant coach. The team will be rostered as a Fire team. Fire will pay Hood, and JFC will pay Hinton.
3. The U15 boys team will be coached by James Gledhill, and assistant coach by Rigo Cedeno. The team will be rostered as a JFC team. JFC will pay Gledhill. Fire will pay Cedeno.

Team Selection. JFC and Fire will allow the Director of Coaches for each club to publicize the clubs agreement to coordinate these teams. The DOC's will schedule joint tryout dates for these age groups. Tryouts will be held at each club's facilities. The teams will be selected by the designated coaches and each club's DOC. In the event of a disagreement over the selection of a player, the designated head coach shall have the final say on player selection.

Participation fees. The club that rosters team will receive all participation fees and will be responsible for all costs and expenses of team except for assistant coach compensation, which will be paid by designated club.

Premier League. The clubs expect the U16 girls and the U15 boys to participate in the Premier League. The rules of the Premier League should be followed if the rules differ from this agreement.

Name. The teams will decide the name to call the team. The team may call itself after rostering organization only or by using a combination of both clubs. The success of each team can be claimed by both clubs, i.e. each could claim them as a club state champion for marketing purposes.

Uniforms. The team's primary uniform will be the club they are rostered with. The team may use the uniforms of either club as they desire.

Practice and Games. The team's primary practice location will be the club that they are rostered with, but may practice and play games at either club's complex(es) by following the club's appropriate rules for scheduling.

Coaches. The coaches shall be the individuals indicated above. The individual team shall be

responsible for all coach(es) travel expenses.

Second Team at Age Group. Each club is free to form a second team in the age group, after "joint" first team is established in an effort to provide soccer for as many players as possible.

Termination. This is a one-year agreement that may be renewed at the mutual agreement of the parties. The decision to renew shall be made before May 1, 2009. If there is no agreement to renew for an additional year, this agreement will end at the completion of the season. When the agreement ends, (a) the club that has the premier league spot for the 2008-09 season shall retain it for the following season, (b) the assigned coach shall return to duties at the club that he was with prior to this agreement and the other club may not hire him/her for the following season, (c) the coach of the coordinated team may not coach this same team, at the succeeding age group for a period of at least one year after the completion of this agreement.
